Senior Logistics Officer

January 2022 – August 2023

- Implemented procurement policy to outsource 250 pieces of technical equipment valued at \$2.2M after identifying critical inventory shortcoming, enabling a thirty km increase in international communications
- Synchronized organization's execution of \$8M+ funds with lead financial analysts for international stakeholders on a biweekly basis; reduced erroneous expenditures by 20% over the course of nine months
- Coordinated deliberate movement for fleet of 52 tactical vehicles across three international borders, resulting in historic first-time use of innovative armament system for foreign partner force
- Streamlined expedited transportation of 350 personnel while serving as emergency first responder throughout global operations, reducing movement timeline by 66% across seven countries

- Supervised distribution services for a 400-person organization; pioneered reporting procedure to streamline accountability of high importance equipment, yielding 30% decrease in equipment losses
- Planned and executed reception of 98 pieces of new equipment valued at \$80M under condensed timeline, fostering organization's ability to safely certify technical procedures
- Spearheaded unit's efforts for divestiture of over 300 pieces of obsolete equipment, generating a 30% budget increase of \$600k from previous fiscal year

Artillery Platoon Leader and Executive Officer (Director Level)

June 2017 – April 2020

- Recognized by evaluators as the *Officer of the Rotation* (out of 230 peers) during international training exercise for possessing outstanding situational awareness and leadership skills under pressure
- Established expedited operating procedures to ensure safety of 80 personnel and \$24M of equipment for six international training exercises, resulting in a 25% reduction in departure time from first to last iteration
- Oversaw training of 60 personnel as project lead in support of equipment transfer overseas, resulting in safe off-load and distribution of 227 pieces of equipment to seven organizations and 5,000 personnel
- Vanguard for gender-integration into combat arms roles; among the first cohort of women to lead a combat-oriented team
